

## DESCRIPTION OF AVAILABLE RIDES

**Brushy Mountain Ride** (13 miles) - Begin at the River Walk in Downtown Rockmart and ride to the 750 foot tunnel under Brushy Mountain Road and back on the Silver Comet Trail. There is a slight uphill grade going out but it's all downhill coming back. Enjoy the view as you pass Euharlee and Thompson Creeks, Ma White's Bottoms, Coot's Lake, Harris Farm and the cool breeze flowing out of Brushy Mountain Tunnel. This trip is perfect for the novice rider or someone who just doesn't want to push too hard on Labor Day.

**Rambo Ride** (31 miles) - Begin at the River Walk in Downtown Rockmart and ride to the Rambo Nursery in Paulding County and back on the Silver Comet Trail. This is an easy 3 hour ride for the average rider. You will enjoy all the sights seen by those on the Brushy Mountain Ride plus cross over the awesome Pumpkintine Trestle. You will enjoy the solitude of riding through the Wild Life Management area between Rockmart and Dallas. There will be no cars to battle and very few roads to cross. It's biking as biking should be!

**'Bama' and Back Ride** (52 miles) - Begin at the River Walk in Downtown Rockmart and ride to the Alabama State Line and back. This ride will be along the rural roads of Polk County and the newly opened 8.4 mile section of the Silver Comet Trail from Cedartown to the Georgia/Alabama State Line. There are a few hills but the scenery will be well worth the effort. The Antioch Community through which you will pass is Polk County at its best. The section of the Silver Comet Trail from Cedartown to Alabama connects with the Chief Ladiga Trail and will make you anxious for the completion of that Trail. This ride is not for the Novice.

**'Bama' - Rambo Ride** (83 miles) - This ride combines the Rambo and 'Bama' Rides with the 'Bama' Ride being completed first for logistical reasons. This ride is for the real Bikers and should not be attempted by the weak of heart.
