





9th Annual Tour de Pike Saturday, March 18th, 2006 8:30 AM – Concord, Georgia

Welcome to the 2005 Tour de Pike!! Please enjoy Pike County's beauty with us. Your route today includes several miles on Georgia Highways 18 and 362. You are urged to ride single file, especially on these roads. The Pike County Sheriff's Department will be assisting at major intersections and will be patrolling the routes but they need your cooperation!!

Route Markings are silver arrows. Diverging and converging routes are marked with "60" or "100."

66 Mile Ride

From Concord, follow GA Hwy 18 West to Molena.

Turn left on GA Hwy 109 to Rest Stop. (7 Miles)

Turn right on Watts Street, then right on Hill Street and left on McCrary Road through Molena residential area and to Pilkenton Road.

Veer left on Pilkenton Road to GA Hwy 109. (11.1 Miles) Right on Hwy 109.

Continue 109 East to U.S. Highway 19 (19 Miles) Following 109, turn left on Hwy 19 for approximately ½ mile.

Turn right onto Ga. Hwy. 109 East.

To Meansville Rest Stop. (21.6 Miles)

Turn left on Collier Ave – becomes Chapman Road To GA Hwy 18.

Left on Hwy 18 to Zebulon Rest Stop (Old Train Sta.) (27 Miles) Take Depot Street North to Jackson Street

Turn Right on Jackson Street (Becomes New Hope Road)

New Hope Road to Caldwell Road. (30.4 Miles)

Left on Caldwell to Gresham Road.

Left on Gresham – Cross US Hwy 19 to Patton Road

Continue Patton Road To Chapel Hill Road. (34.9 Miles)

Left on Chapel Hill Road to GA Hwy 362

Left on Hwy 362 to Williamson. (38.9 Miles)

Left on Zebulon/Williamson Road to Rest Stop.

Return to Hwy 362 West. (44.4 Miles)

Continue Hwy 362 West to Mt. Carmel Road.

Left on Mt. Carmel to Gay. (56.4 Miles)

Left on Evans Street to Flat Shoals Road. Left on Flat Shoals Road to <u>Rest Stop</u>.

(OPTIONAL: Historic Covered Bridge 2 Miles down dirt road at 59.6 mile mark.)

Continue Flat Shoals Road to GA Hwy 18.

Left on Hwy 18 to Concord. Finish (66 Miles)
